Linnéa Lillienberg is a certified occupational hygienist who has worked at the Department of Occupational and Environmental Medicine at Sahlgrenska University Hospital in Gothenburg, Sweden since 1977. Linnéa has a PhD in chemistry and is an associate professor of Occupational Hygiene.

Linnéa's research focuses on exposure assessment of dust and aerosols and obstructive airway diseases in epidemiologic projects concerning bakers, hairdressers and machine operators exposed to metalworking fluids. She has also been working on job exposure matrices (JEM) and asthma in the general population.

Linnéa has been involved in the development of the occupational hygiene profession, a board member of the Swedish Association of Occupational and Environmental Hygiene and the International Occupational Hygiene Association (IOHA) for many years, and the President of IOHA in 1995.
