



# Foundation Scholarship Program

## Program Guidelines for the 2019-2020 Academic Year

The application period for the ILMA Scholarship is April 1 – June 30, 2019.  
Recipients will be notified in late August 2019.

The scholarship funds may be used toward tuition, books, or room and board and will be given directly to the student or the academic institution (student's choice). The scholarship is awarded up to four years, renewable annually, based on the maintenance of a 3.0 cumulative GPA. The amount of the scholarship shall be up to \$3,000 annually per award. In order to be eligible to apply, applicants must:

- be a citizen of a North American country
- enroll or be enrolled for the 2018-2019 academic year at a college or university in North America as an under-graduate
- register as a full-time student (12 credit hours or more per semester, 9 credit hours or more per trimester)
- have a minimum 3.0 cumulative grade point average (GPA)
- send in a copy of their Official Transcript to be considered for a scholarship (*college students can obtain one from their university's registrar office; high school students can obtain one from their school's record office*)

The following items are also taken into consideration, in the order below:

- Relationship to ILMA member company  
*PLEASE NOTE: Children of company owners (including partial and minority owners) are NOT eligible to apply*
- Financial need
- Cumulative GPA
- Preference will be given to those with majors in Math, Science and Engineering

All applicants must submit an essay on why they should receive this scholarship. Topics should include:

- How the scholarship will benefit future education endeavors; and,
- Any "special circumstances" (i.e., applicant is the first child to go to college, comes from a single parent household, or need-based financial assistance, etc.).

Applicants may also provide these items that may be taken into consideration:

- Community involvement
- Extracurricular activities and/or sports or athletic involvement
- Letter(s) of recommendation from teacher(s) or advisor(s)
